### How Can I Be Mentally Pure?

**Scripture reference:**  
1 Corinthians 2:6-16

**Level of Biblical Learning:** Self-control and obedience to God can help you stand up to peer pressure. Self-control honors God and benefits you.

**Introduction:** How do you get wisdom? In 1 Corinthians, Paul said there is no real human wisdom. True wisdom comes from God through the Holy Spirit. In Romans 7, Paul explained that the Spirit of God has searched the deepest thoughts of the mind of man and the very depths of God. The most wonderful part of the message is that this powerful wisdom rests in the mind of every believer. Through this lesson you can know that the things you watch, say, and do will affect your thoughts, attitudes, and actions.
