# The Mission of Open Christian Homes

If you want to really get to know someone, live with them in their home. The art and pictures that hang on the walls, the books they read, the TV programs they watch, all provide a wealth of information about a person that can't be found in our casual relationships outside a home. More importantly, witnessing how a family interacts with each

other while contributing to the "home", how a Father treats his Wife, how He treats his Children, are just a few of the things that are so important to know about a person yet can't be observed anywhere except within the home. No wonder that throughout the 2000 year missiology of our Lord's Church, the Christian Home has been a cornerstone in the expansion of our Lord's Kingdom. None of our homes are perfect, but the Love, Joy, and Peace given by our Lord and demonstrated in our homes is a living witness to His Grace that needs to be shared with each other and the lost at any opportunity that our Lord provides. The World is coming to Midland not only to work, but to learn and train in the advanced techniques necessary to commercially produce unconventional reserves. This boom has provided each of us opportunities to open our homes for those in need.

One such need coming up is our local missions partner Rock the Desert. Rock the Desert is the 5th largest Christian Music Festival in the Country with thousands of Youth finding eternal Salvation through Jesus Christ at this festival over the past 17 years – last year we had 157 salvations through public professions of Faith with 29 choosing to be baptized at the Festival amongst 12,000 who attended and heard the Word of God through music and testimony. The price of a hotel room for most small town youth groups is now out of reach for them to attend the Festival as designed. At FBC-Midland, we have an opportunity to open our homes to let teenagers and their sponsors to "camp out" in our living rooms three nights allowing them to attend all three days of our festival and worship with us that Sunday morning. A typical small town youth group will be 7 to 15 people (sponsors included). The kids will all have sleeping bags and pillows so they won't take up much room. NOW HIRING - Full Time Director of Food Services


