LOTTIE MOON OFFERING BEGINS THIS WEEK!





Dear First Baptist Midland,

First, let me just say, thank you!

Your recent donation means that you understand just how devastating Hurricane Harvey was here on the coast.

But let me tell you what we have been able to do with the resources you and others have provided.

- More than 30 families in our church have either lost their home or been displaced
 while repairs are being made. Because of you, we are able to help all of these families
 overcome the financial burden of losing their home.
- We have provided VISA gift cards to church families and local school employee families to help with their recovery.
- We have provided resources to help establish a volunteer and help center for our community to connect those in need and those who want to help.
- We have supplied food, water, cleaning supplies, toiletries, chainsaws, air conditioners, generators and more.
