May we each take time to thank God for the many blessings we've received this year! Spend some time with Psalm 100. Read it aloud, read it to your family, pray it as a prayer and above all, take time to praise the God of all goodness who will carry us all the way home.

HOPE FOR THE HOLIDAYS

As much as I love the holiday season, this one will be different than any I've had before. My mother loved Thanksgiving. Until I was 25, her side of the family always held a reunion on Thanksgiving Day. It was a highlight of the year, not just the fall. She looked forward to it as did we all. This will be her first Thanksgiving at Jesus' table. There's joy in knowing that but still a keen sense of loss. Maybe like me and my family, you've lost someone this year and are having a difficult time with it. This Sunday afternoon at 4 PM in our chapel, we'll honor those we've lost this year and share a service together. Larry Grimes (a licensed counselor as well our Business Administrator) will lead us in a talk about coping with that loss. Each family will receive a fantastic book called "Experiencing Grief" that has helped me and many others. We will be done before the Thanksgiving meal. No RSVP necessary for the service. Just come and share this time with us as we find HOPE FOR THE HOLIDAYS.

THANKSGIVING DINNER

One of the best parts of being a family is sitting down to meals together. I'm so excited to share this meal with my church family! I hope you've made plans to join us! We'll begin serving around 5 PM.

THE GIFT

I'm glad to tell you almost all of the children who needed to be adopted for THE GIFT have been picked up. We will have a few more this Sunday especially for our family in the Traditional Service (I'll be speaking there this Sunday by the way!). Some of you have asked what else you can do? December 2nd, at 3:30

PM in our fellowship hall, we'll hold a meeting for all who want to serve with THE GIFT. If you signed up through VOMO, we'll send you an email. If you didn't, come anyway. Currently, we have about 30 who have volunteered. We need about 170 not counting our drama friends in the chapel.

To clarify our plans, we've narrowed our efforts to December 8th only. We believe we can serve all our families in one day with 3 volunteer shifts. Each shift will last 3 hours. Beginning next Sunday, November 25th, in your Worship Guide you'll find a map and description of the plans for THE GIFT and a map of the work-flow of the building. We need lots of hands ready to serve and love people. Make this a part of teaching your children and grandchildren about serving Christ and His people, about missions and about reaching Midland. Build this into your schedule as a priority! You'll know the power and presence of Christ at Christmas best when you serve. This is your best chance. Meet us Dec 2nd to find out how.
