



## PERSONNEL COMMITTEE AND CHURCH COUNCIL CALLED MEETING MINUTES

The Personnel Committee and Church Council of First Baptist Church of Midland, Texas met for a special called meeting on Wednesday, May 31, 2017. Chairman Danny Campbell called the meeting to order at 7:00PM.
