

Sunday Sermon Notes: February 18, 2018

Milestone #1 - Worship - Psalm 122

"Worship is our response, both publically and privately, to God for who he is, what he Has done and what he WILL do." – Pastor Louie Giglio

I. My heart will guide my worship, not my circumstances – v. 1-2

- True worship is voluntary
- True worship invites me to surrender my agenda
- True worship demands a look up, not around.

II. My worship will define my reality – v. 3-5

- Several key themes that anchor me deeply to the reality of God and His word:
 - God is eternal!
 - o God cares for me!
 - o God has provided for me!

III. My worship will both satisfy and create hunger! v. 6-9

- So why do so many miss it?
 - Hurry
 - o Ignorance
 - o Šin

How do we avoid these and find ourselves in God's presence?

- By allowing worship to take time. I'm committed to staying in God's presence even if there is no feeling to it.
- By seeking true worship. Its God focused, not preference based. Its focused on honoring God not exalting the leader. Its focused on leading us to God, not back to ourselves.
- **By seeking brokenness.** While that doesn't sound like fun, only then can we truly realize the price we are paying for sin in our lives how it prevents us from fulfilling our hunger for worship.
